PRINCIPAL REPORT:

- Moved towards a common lunch for all students and it's been successful. This gives

 sports, etc. This also provides extra quite time and homework help (classrooms and library
 open, safe spaces), and the staff in the cafeteria were able to handle the volume; 30 new

- SHSM Arts and Culture program has begun Truth & Reconciliation Day @ Living Arts Centre, PAMA visit planned, and Rose Theatre
- We have received/hung new banners on the school for SHSM and French programs at the school; important to make sure arts, language & sports equally supported
- Uniform and cell phone check-ins have been in effect and the goal is to gradually move towards keeping within the policy which is an all-black shoe. Also wearing the new blue pants for grade 9 and optional for other grades who want to update their uniform. There is currently 2 blue pants and one gray pant option. We are gradually moving to all blue (not the chino style pant).
