	This course examines computer systems and control of external devices. Students will assemble computers and small networks by installing and configuring appropriate hardware and software. Students will develop knowledge and skills in electronics, robotics, programming, and networks, as will build systems that use computer programs and interfaces to control and respond to external devices. Students will develop an awareness of related environmental and societal issues, and will learn about college and universit programs leading to careers in computer technology. This course will help students address the Ontario Catholic Graduate Expectation that they become effective communicators who use and integrated the Catholic faith tradition in a critical analysis of the arts, media, technology and information systems.
